## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

**Covid-19** – Vaccination is required by request of our in-country partner. Due to this worldwide pandemic, drops of grace will adhere to all protocols provided by the Malawian government as well as the guidelines for International travel.

**Do I need a passport?** Yes! Please go to <a href="http://travel.state.gov/">http://travel.state.gov/</a> for more information regarding passports. Your passport must have at least 4 blank pages and be valid six months past your departure date from the country you are visiting. Please make copies of your passport to leave at home with family and/or friends as a reference in the event you misplace your passport during your trip.

**Do I need a visa?** Yes, but *drops of grace* procures the visa for you. This is included in your fees.

## Does drops of grace require that I have traveler's insurance?

No, this is your personal choice. Should you acquire traveler's insurance please note it will be at your expense.

**Travel/Meals/Accommodations:** Accommodations, travel arrangements, meals, and fresh water while in country are included in the base price of the trip. *drops of grace* procures all accommodations in a safe and comfortable setting. We even give the trip T-shirt to prove it!

**Medical Insurance:** International travel accident and sickness insurance policy will be provided. Medical, Evacuation & Mortal Remains return included. This coverage is included in cost of trip and is secondary coverage while in country. Participant should contact primary care coverage to determine coverage out of country.

**Projects and Objectives:** We will have small educational, and skills training teams to work with children, teachers & counselors. We may be called upon to assist in food distribution, volunteer at selected mission sites, meet and encourage widows & children, and assist local HBC (home based care) & GBV (gender based violence) volunteers with leadership training.

**Funding:** Team members are encouraged to request mission funds from their friends & family. A sample "appeal letter" is available by request that can be adapted and sent to family members and friends.
